The Division of Orthopedic Surgery at Queen's University offers a comprehensive one-year Sports Medicine fellowship. The fellowship is open to appropriately qualified Canadian and internationally trained orthopedic surgeons who are seeking additional subspecialty training in sports medicine.

The postgraduate fellow will receive a broad clinical and academic exposure to arthroscopic and open: knee, shoulder and ankle reconstruction. The postgraduate fellow will also provide Team Physician coverage for a varsity level sports team.

Further responsibilities include research and teaching requirements, and those with aspirations of further academic careers will be encouraged to complete a project for presentation or publication. Preference will be given to training of 12 months duration, although 6 month postings may be arranged.

Eligibility for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario is preferred. Funding is available from the Division of Orthopedics for licensed Canadian candidates. International candidates with external funding will also be considered.
