Dr. Daniel Leff trained in oncoplastic breast surgery at several centres of excellence including the breast unit at Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust and the Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust. He is cross appointed to the Department of Surgery and Cancer in the Faculty of Medicine at Imperial College London.

Daniel has undergone advanced Oncoplastic training having been competitively selected for a Training Interface Group (TIG) National Oncoplastic Fellowship, one of only nine such training posts in the United Kingdom. He trained at several centres of excellence in breast cancer and reconstructive breast surgery including the Imperial Breast Unit, the Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust and the St Andrews Centre for Plastic Surgery in Chelmsford. Daniel has a Master of Surgery degree in Oncoplastic Breast Surgery. In 2016, he won the "Issac Gukas Medal" for achievement in breast surgery.



His research interests include studying and improving surgical performance and minimising re-operation rates following breast conserving surgery through innovative technologies.
